PROGRAM OVERVIEW

PLANETARY HEALTH:

Planetary Health is the health of human civilization and the state of the natural systems on which it depends (Rockefeller Foundation-Lancet Planetary Health Commission Report, 2015). Unprecedented degradation of the environment has ongoing deleterious effects on man and nature. These effects remain largely unknown and unquantified. Healthcare professionals must therefore commit to curbing the environmental onslaught and the detrimental effects on health through interdisciplinary, collaborative approaches.

PROFESSIONAL MOBILITY:

Filipino nurses working overseas face a myriad of challenges from agency recruitment to job employment. This session will discuss experiences on professional mobility and Philippine labor standards; and the accountability and responsibility of all stakeholders (the recruitment agency, the employer and the nurse) to provide nurses with continued access to their employment options.
