**POSTER ABSTRACT CATEGORIES:**

**Administration/Leadership Development/Professional Practice:** showcase a successful project or program that your unit, institution, or organization has conducted in the past year

**Clinical/Evidence-Based Practice:** issues, application of products, programs, trends in patient care, nursing-sensitive patient outcomes, and/or use of research findings and/or best evidence with nursing clinical practice or research implications

**Education:** educational programs and issues (may be based in service or academia and patient or nurse focused)

**Research:** in progress or completed nursing research studies.

**GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

1. All abstracts must be submitted through the online abstract submission system. Please review the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION CHECKLIST below before accessing the online abstract submission system.
2. The components of the abstract are divided into sections to help authors assure that they have included all the required information based upon the scoring criteria. Authors are encouraged to write the abstract in a word processing file (e.g. MS Word).
3. The final abstract (body of abstract) must be no more than 300 words.
4. The online abstract submission system will not allow you to move forward with the application unless all required fields are completed.
5. To ensure consistent, high-quality content, all abstracts must be organized into the required format based upon the abstract category. A panel of judges from the US and the Philippines will score the abstracts based on the required headings.
6. The abstract title should clearly indicate the nature of the subject. Acronyms should not be used in the title and should be written out on first mention. A quantifiable objective must be submitted and the body of the abstract should be in paragraph form, using complete sentences, and avoiding special characters. Abstracts should have all funding sources written out completely if applicable.
7. For abstracts with more than one author, the presenting author will be considered the contact person.
8. Abstracts **MUST** be submitted on or before **November 15, 2017**.

- Must complete the Conflict of Interest (COI) statement
- Abstract (not to exceed 300 words)
