Last year, the MDCONRC hosted over 400 nursing students and professionals from more than 30 nursing colleges and 20 medical institutions nationwide, featured keynote and

plenary speakers, and recognized best papers refereed by local and international nursing experts. This grand academic gathering aims to further inspire nursing students and professionals to be involved in nursing research as research knowledge helps them become excellent nursing professionals.

She has been involved in policy development and health research since 2003. Before joining the Commission, she worked with the National Telehealth Center of the University of the Philippines-Manila in establishing legal frameworks for Telemedicine, use of electronic health records, and other eHealth initiatives. She is a member of the National Health Data Privacy Experts Group of the National eHealth Program. She was tapped primarily to assist in the development of the "Privacy Guidelines for the Philippine Health Information Exchange", one of the first sectoral privacy regulations in the country.

He was also Editor-in Chief of the Asian Bioethics Review since its founding in 2008. He has been an officer; committee member and consultant in different organizations, among these are UNESCO International Bioethics Committee, European Union and the European Commission, and National Transplant Ethics Committee.

Michael Joseph R. Diño, PhD, RN

Director, Research Development and Innovation Center Our Lady of Fatima University

He is active in research activities and conferences locally and globally. His research and scholarly works have promoted effective teaching approaches, model of technology adoption among elderly, and the ideal electronic health record interface for healthcare providers. He has also received a number of recognitions; among these are Nurse in the Limelight Research Innovator Award by Sanofi and Connecting Nurses in partnership with International Council of Nurses, and Global Apple Distinguished Educator in 2013. He is the Vice-President of the Philippine Nursing Research Society and a member of the Sigma Theta Tau International, Honor Society of Nursing.

10th MDCON Research Congress SYNOPSIS

The Manila Doctors College of Nursing (MDCON) successfully conducted its 10th Research Congress with the theme "Building the Science and Practice of Nursing through Innovative Evidence-based Discourse" last January 18, 2017. The Congress was attended by over 400 student and professional nurses from 40 nursing colleges and 18 healthcare institutions in Metro Manila, Luzon, and Visayas that included University of Santo Tomas, Far Eastern University, West Visayas State University, University of Cordilleras, Angeles University Foundation, Philippine General Hospital, Asian Hospital and Medical Center, and St. Luke's Medical Center. This grand academic gathering was graced by esteemed nursing luminaries as guest speakers. Dr. Cora A. Añonuevo, member of the PRC-Board of Nursing delivered her keynote address. Dr. Michael C. Leocadio, Associate Dean, Training and Community Services, Sultan Oaboos University, Oman; Dr. Maria Linda G. Buhat, Assistant Director, Nursing Services, Philippine Heart Center; and Dr. Teresita I Barcelo, Dean, Graduate School, Centro Escolar University, who shared their insights, perspectives and experiences on cross cultural nursing in the plenary.
